Explanatory note regarding the Call Sign of vessels registered in the Swedish Register of Ships


According to the Swedish Maritime Code of 1994, chapter 1, section 8, a vessel that is registered in the Swedish Register of Ships shall be allocated an identification signal. Hence, the Swedish Register of Shipping allocates a call sign for any registered vessel as the vessels identification signal. No additional identification for the vessel, as an official number or similar, shall be allocated to the vessel.

Therefore, on any Certificate of Nationality or Certificate of Registration issued by the Swedish Register of Shipping, part of the Swedish Transport Agency, there is only a Call Sign given for the vessel, no official number or similar.

The call sign of the vessel is to be considered the official number of a vessel registered in the Swedish Register of Ships.
